



2017 Shea Vineyard Pinot Noir

Since 2003 we have worked with the Shea family and their impressive 140-acre vineyard property in the middle of the sandy Yamhill-Carlton AVA. Bergström Wines has historically purchased fruit from six different clonal blocks, totaling 16 acres, on the East Hill of the Shea Vineyard: Oak Block, Blocks 5, 9, 14, 16, and 19.

The 2017 Bergström Wines Shea Vineyard Pinot Noir is a gorgeous light cranberry color. It has effusive aromas of gingerbread, Chinese five spice, curry, and garam masala with cedar and sandalwood-like incense. Its distinct herbal and floral bouquet helps make this wine one of the more aromatically complex wines of the 2017 lineup, even at this early phase. This Pinot Noir is also intensely perfumed in the mouth, and has great energy, fruit sweetness, and juicy acidity with fine, elegant ripe tannins that coat the palate. Structured but succulent and fruit forward, this is a very good vintage for the Shea Vineyard and this wine will drink fantastic young as with 3-8 years of bottle age. Drink now through 2027+
